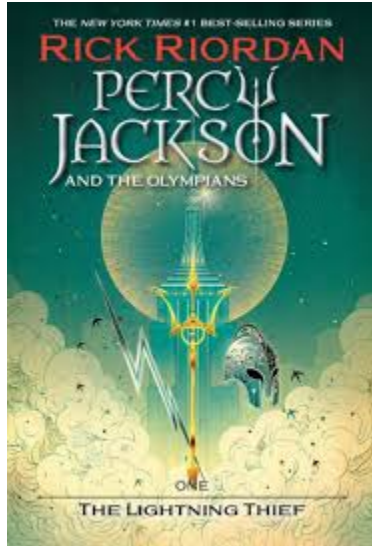


## Millennium Charter Academy's 6th Grade Summer Reading
